CONTRACT AWARD

G.1 AWARD SELECTION

- A. VRE will make the award to the lowest responsible and responsive Bidder conforming to the solicitation's requirements. **For evaluation purposes, award will be made on the basis of the base bid only or the combination of the base bid and the alternate bid, as selected by VRE after receipt of bids. Therefore, the Contract will be for the base bid, with the option for north platform repairs and modifications (the Alternate Bid) retained by VRE.** Discounts for prompt payment will not be considered in making awards. Past experience performing the services described herein and the Bidder's capacity to perform the work will be taken into consideration in making the award.
- B. The award document will be a Contract incorporating by reference the Invitation for Bids, Terms and Conditions, Contract Provisions, Scope of Work and/or Technical Specifications, and the Contractor's bid, governed by the precedence of terms and provisions of the General Terms and Conditions.
- C. VRE may cancel this IFB or reject bids at any time prior to an award and is not required to furnish a statement of the reason why a particular bid was not deemed to be the most advantageous (Code of Virginia, § 2.2-4359D).

G.2 NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD

In addition to any verbal notice that VRE may make to Bidders, bid results will be posted at the VRE Website: www.vre.org. VRE will post the Notice of Intent to Award on its website for a minimum of ten (10) days. The Notice of Intent to Award shall not be construed as a "Notice to Proceed" (NTP).
