JUNE UPDATES

Over the course of two weekends in May, we completed the first two phases of Jump Span Installations. Jump spans are temporary bridges supporting the rail which allows new bridge foundations to be built behind the existing foundations, away from the road. This method separates construction activities from the public right-of-way, minimizing impacts to pedestrian and vehicular traffic beneath the existing bridges.

The final weekend of jump span installations is scheduled for:

- June 18th until June 24th
- Start Thursday 6:30pm
- Finish Wednesday 6:30am



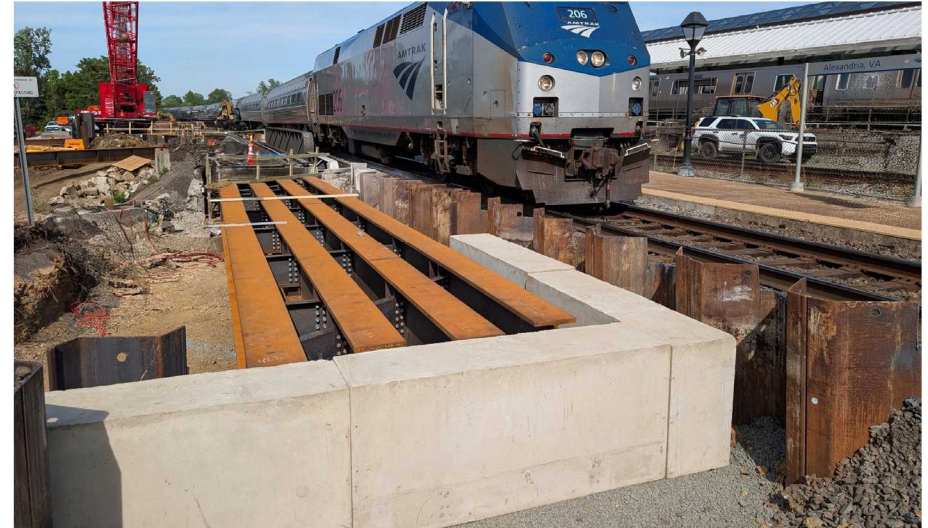
TRAFFIC IMPACTS DURING JUMP SPAN WEEKEND INSTALLATIONS:

Roadway Impacts:

- ▶ King Street will be fully closed between Russell Road and Daingerfield Rd. Traffic will be detoured to Duke St.
- ▶ Commonwealth Avenue will remain open with single travel lane alternating traffic directed by flaggers.

Sidewalk Impacts:

- ▶ Sidewalk connecting King Street to the station tunnel is closed. Follow detour signage to use the station ramp.
- ▶ Stairs from the east platform to King Street will be closed through the end of the project



The new temporary platform is now in service! It provides easier boarding for trains on Tracks 1 and 2 throughout construction. A new temporary pedestrian crossing is also available, giving riders direct access to the temporary platform—please see the station agent for assistance with utilizing the crossing.
